On Post-Secondary Day each year, over 40 Atlantic region post-secondary institutions send representatives to MRHS to provide information to our high school students about their programs. Included are universities, community colleges and private school offering a wide variety of courses and programs. This is a wonderful opportunity to meet reps, ask questions, and help you focus on opportunities that exist for you beyond high school. Make sure to take full advantage! Included is a list of the institutions that will have reps in attendance. Explore the websites for each school. The list of websites is also included on the MRHS website with live links. Below is a list of suggested questions to get you thinking about the information you would like to gather.

Grade 12 students are invited to attend breakout sessions with Acadia, Dalhousie, NSCC, Saint Mary's, and St FX. Be sure to sign up in the school main lobby.

- Grade 12 students are expected to sign up for sessions of their choice on the sheets that will be in the main lobby. If you do not choose to attend particular sessions, you are expected to visit the reps in the cafeteria. Grade 10 and 11 students will not sign up for sessions, but may visit reps in classrooms after 11:35, or circulate in the cafeteria.
  
- The format for the visit is as follows:
  - 10:45 – 11:10 - All students released from classes to attend. Grade 12 students go to first session for which they have signed up. Grade 10 and 11 students in gym
  - 11:15 – 11:35 – Grade 12 students move to second session or go to the gym
  - 11:35 – 12:00 – All students either in gym or visiting reps in assigned classrooms
